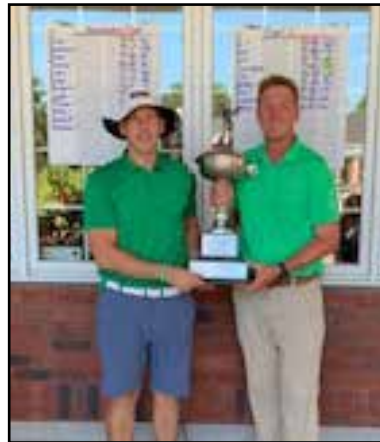


Members of The Quincy Country Club,

The “root” in the name of Hires' concoction came from its main ingredient, the sassafras root. Hires changed the name of his product from “tea” to “beer” sometime before the Philadelphia Centennial Exposition in 1876. It's likely that he changed the name to make the beverage more appealing to the working class.

Come out and experience something a “*Little Different*” at your club!

Here is a list of some of the Root Beer's that may be tasted:

Natural Brewed Draft Root Beer- Has a very rooty and herby taste

Bundaberg- A foreign brew from Australia, has a very rooty and bitey taste

Virgil's- One of the more healthy brews that has a natural and rooty taste with a sweet after taste

Maine Root Beer- Also healthy brew that has a very light and balanced taste

Sprecher root beer- has a heavy, sweet taste but more balanced than other sweet brews

Boylan root beer- has a sweet taste but then the after taste is corny

Sioux City Root Beer- Has a balanced taste but is more sweet than rooty

Wbc Goose Island Root Beer- balanced sweetness and rootness

Triple XXX- mostly balanced taste

IBC root beer- Balanced but more sweetness in the taste

Fitz's root beer- creamy and very sweet taste

Money Bag- caramel sweet taste

Frostie root beer- sweet full taste

Abita- Generally sweet taste

Hank's root beer- sweet taste


